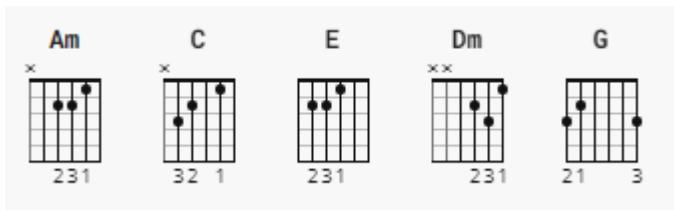


Blue October - What If We Could
